Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) Program Schedule Options

Day Class: Monday through Friday from 8:00am-4:30pm

- 4 weeks, 20 days (5 days a week)
- 40 clock/credit hours per week= 20 days = total 160 clock/credit hours total

Evening & Saturday: Monday through Thursday from 5:00pm-10:00pm & Saturday 8:00am-4:30pm

- 6 weeks, 30 days (5 days a week)
- Approximately 27 clock/credit hours per week = 30 days = 160 clock/credit hours total

Enrollment Checklist

All requirements must be submitted at one time (registration appointment).

- Enrollment form (complete)
- Health questionnaire (complete)
- Live scan fingerprint form (complete)
- Physical exam (complete)
- TB test results (negative result confirmation documentation)
- Results cannot be older than 6 months
- *Proof of COVID-19 vaccination (complete)*
- COVID-19 test results (negative result confirmation documentation)
- High school/college diploma (or unofficial transcript), GED equivalent...
 - Foreign diplomas must have official English translation
 - If unable to attain the above, you will need to schedule and take the ATB test. Arrange an appointment with Danny to take the ATB test. It may take you 30 minutes to 1 hour to take the test depending upon your English skills. It takes 1-2 weeks to receive the results of your ATB test. *This means you need to take the ATB test 3-4 weeks before the 1st day of class.*
- CA driver's license/ID card, or valid passport
 - Must be current: correct name, correct address, not expired
- Social security card
 - Physical card must be in your possession and must *not* be laminated
- \$440.50 payment (cash, money order, credit card payments accepted)
 - \$440.50 = \$100 (non-refundable registration fee) + \$0.50 (non-refundable state-imposed mandated fund fee) + \$40 (CNA textbook) + \$300 (1st installment for tuition)

Other Fees

White Uniform Nursing Scrub (1 pair)	\$25.00
Blood Pressure Cuff (Sphygmomanometer) with Stethoscope	\$20.00
Safety Gait Belt	\$15.00
CPR Certification	\$100.00

- ❖ White uniform scrub is not required during CNA program (currently not doing skills lab at a skilled nursing facility)
- ❖ BP cuff with stethoscope is not required due to COVID-19 (currently not doing skills lab at a skilled nursing facility)
- ❖ Safety gait belt (optional cost)
- ❖ At VIP Nursing School, the only CPR certification we offer is American Heart Association BLS (Basic Life Support) for Providers. It is an optional cost. You are not required to receive your CPR certification at VIP Nursing School along with your CNA program.

Notes Regarding CNA Program Associated Fees/Costs

- I did not account for the fees for: Physical exam with TB test, COVID-19 test, and Live Scan Fingerprinting. The reason for this is because I cannot know for sure how much these will cost you. You will have to find out how much it is and add it to the total above.
- Your tuition can be reduced from \$900.00 to \$850.00 only if you pay the entire \$850.00 within the *first week of class and it must be paid in cash*. Credit card payments do not receive the \$50.00 discount. Most people do not do this, so I accounted for normal tuition costs.
- I did not add the American Heart Association BLS for Providers Course (CPR certification), because it is an optional cost. You are not required to take the BLS class at VIP Nursing School. However, you must be BLS certified to work (as a CNA) in a healthcare setting like a skilled nursing facility or a hospital. Normally, our students take the BLS class after they have passed the CNA certification exam. Cost for the BLS classes at VIP Nursing School is \$100.00. You may find other BLS classes with a simple Google search.
